

\$50 Air Conditioning Tune-Up Rebate>>>



Clogged coils, low refrigerant levels, plugged drain lines and a host of minor problems can greatly affect the efficiency of your central air conditioner. Inefficiencies can drive up power bills, especially if we experience a hot summer.

To help our members save energy this year, Crow Wing Power is offering a \$50 rebate to residential customers to tune-up their central air conditioners.

- Our rebate funds are limited therefore it's best to contact us first to make sure we still have rebates available. (Contact us at info@cwpower.com or call us at 218-829-2827 or 1-800-648-9401.)

- Contact one of the certified HVAC contractors listed on Crow Wing Power's web-site to schedule a tune-up on your A/C. The list is on a quick link at cwpower.com. If you don't have internet access, call the office and we can send a list to you.
- Arrange to have one of the A/C tune-up rebate forms sent to you, or stop by the office to pick one up.
- Have your HVAC contractor perform the tune-up and fill in the rebate form.
- Send the completed rebate form to us (the deadline to turn it in is September 30, 2010) and we'll send you a check for \$50 in about 4-6 weeks.

There are a few restrictions:

- The program is for existing "central air conditioners" installed before December 31, 2007. (window units don't qualify)
- The A/C unit has to be operational; the rebate is for an efficiency "Tune-Up", not for "Repairs".
- No utility reimbursed tune-ups within the last two years.

The A/C doesn't have to be on one of Crow Wing Power's cycled air programs, but it's a good idea to maximize your savings. To control costs, our rebate funds are limited this year, and may run out before the end of the season. Please check with us before lining up your HVAC contractor.
